

INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES:

END-SEMESTER EXAMINATIONS

1. It is mandatory for the candidates to bring their Admit Card at all times during the examination. If a candidate forgets their admit card, they may obtain a provisional admit card from the LDC with the Centre Superintendent's approval. This is allowed only once. Repeated failure to produce an admit card will result in denial of entry to the examination hall.

2. Candidates may enter the examination hall 30 minutes prior to the commencement of the exam. No candidate is allowed to be admitted to the examination hall 15 minutes after the commencement of the examination.

3. Candidates must leave all personal belongings (bags, mobile phones, notes, etc.) in the open, visible area outside their examination room. Belongings may not be stored elsewhere, including other rooms or restrooms. Calculators may be permitted for certain papers/subjects.

4. Candidates are generally not permitted to leave the examination hall once the exam has commenced. In exceptional circumstances, such as for restroom breaks, only one candidate will be allowed to leave at a time under the supervision of an invigilator.

5. Candidates found engaging in any form of malpractice, including but not limited to:

- Possession of unauthorized materials.
- Copying from another candidate.
- Allowing another candidate to copy from them.
- Using electronic devices for unfair means.
- Impersonation.
- Any other attempt to gain an unfair advantage.

will be immediately expelled from the examination hall. Such cases will be reported to the Controller of Examinations, Mizoram University, for further disciplinary action.

6. No candidate shall be allowed to leave the examination hall before an expiration of 1 hour from the commencement of the exam.

7. Warning will be given 15 minutes before the hour fixed for completion of examination. Final signal will be announced at the completion of the examination duration. No candidates can write after the examination duration expires.

8. All candidates must submit their answer sheets (even blank/unused answer sheets) to the invigilators before leaving the examination hall.

9. Candidates must strictly follow invigilator instructions. Any misconduct, threats, or intimidation toward invigilators or supervisory staff will result in immediate expulsion from the examination hall and will be reported to both the Controller of Examinations and local police for legal action.

10. Invigilators reserve the right to inspect any item brought into the examination vicinity, as well as to conduct personal checks of candidates, to ensure compliance with these regulations.
