# Commencement:

- English Drive: The responsibility of this drive will be given to the Department of English to impart into the students and enhance their language skills, the platform for which will be during the moring assembly on days allotted for the drive.
   Emphasis will be on 'word of the day', 'idioms' and 'grammar'
- 2. Cleanliness Drive: This drive will concentrate on imparting the importance of cleanliness and good health. The in-charge department may be decided later.
- Punctuality Drive: this drive will concentrate on the main issue of 'time management' and the importance of having the skills to manage time for efficiency in studying (student) and work (staff).
- 4. Ettiquette and Zonunmawi: This drive is to impart and instil into every member of the HATIM community, the importance of manners and etiquette not only of the general social ettiquete defined universally in all parts of the world but also to keep alive "zonunmawi" which literally translate as "The beautiful ways of Mizo life". The emphasis is on the mizo culture mannerism that is beautiful and acceptable in the society. For example: the concept of 'Tlawngaihna" which is the 'self-lessness'; respect for elders, etc.

These drives are activated because learning is not only about the academic syllabus learning but also about like skills. And the college deemed it important that the duty of the college is to provide a platform for all members to be able to learn and grow in all aspects of learning.
