


REPORT ON FACULTY EXCHANGE PROGRAMME




Higher and Technical Institute, Mizoram (HATIM) with Government Serchhip College




Mr. H.Lalruatkima from HATIM delivered a lecture on "Digital Fundamentals" on 30th August 2021

Memorandum of Understanding for Faculty Exchange Programme Between Govt. Serchhip College

Higher and Technical Institute, Mizoram (HATIM)

The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is established between Govt Serchlip College and HATIM for the purpose of Faculty Exchange Programme agreement.

PARTICIPATING PARTIES

- I. Govi. Serehhip College
- 2. Higher and Technical Institute, Mizoram (HATIM)

Terms of MoU:

- The two parties agree to enter into a Faculty Exchange Programme agreement, commencing in the Academic year 2020-2021.
- ii) The participating faculties will register at the host institution for the academic/present semester session.
- iii) Each institution may send up to three faculties as per semester to participate in the exchange. Either institution may send a faculty for one semester rather than a full academic year. The number of the faculty may be increased subject to the neutral agreement of both institutions.
- iv) It is expected that there will be an equal number of faculty exchanged from each institution.
- v) Not withstanding clauses iii and iv above, while equal number numbers in every semester may not be possible, efforts will be made to have equal exchange during one academic year.
- vi) Each institution will appoint an individual to act as the co-ordinator for the exchange. The exchange is co-ordinated in Govt. Serchhip College, Serchhip through the co-ordinator and in HATIM, Lunglei through the co-ordinator.
- vii) The host institutions will have the right of refusal of any candidate who may appear to be unacceptable for the exchange. Each sending institution will follow the exchange application deadlines set by the receiving institution.

FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

viii) The institution in the exchange will pay the compulsory TA/DA to the respective participant at the home institution prior to departure for the host institution. However, financial implications of the exchange shall be individually considered as per the situation.

RESOURCES AND REGULATIONS AT THE HOST INSTITUTION

ix) Faculty participating in the program will be free to choose courses from the full range of semester courses at the respective host's institution provided that they satisfy the courses' prerequisites.

- x) At the end of the exchange programme, the host institution shall send a report/official transcript of their (academic achievement) to the home institution.
- xi) Faculties participating in the programme are subjected to the rules and regulations of the host institution. The host institution reserves the right to dismiss any participating faculty at any time for academic or personal misconduct. The dismissal of a participant shall not abrogate the agreement for the arrangements regarding other participants.

DURATION, AMENDMENT AND TERMINATION OF AGREEMENT

xii) The parties will review the terms of the MoU as and when deemed necessary to assess the success of the exchange and will determine whether to continue, modify or discontinue the MoU. Each party reserves the right to terminate this MoU upon one month written notice to the other.

xiii) The MoU shall take effect when signed by both parties and will remain in effect until and unless both parties resolve to terminate the programme.
