REPORT ON FACULTY EXCHANGE PROGRAMME

DERARTMENT OF EDUCATION, HATIM AND DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION GOVERNMENT SERCHHIP COLLEGE

In pursuance of the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) dated 10th March 2021 signed between Higher and Technical Institute Mizoram (HATIM) and Government Serchhip College for Faculty Exchange Programme, the Department of Education took part in this Programme on the 15th and 16th of September, 2021. Due to the pandemic, the Exchange Programme was carried out through online mode.

On 11th September 2021 both the faculties of the Department of Education of HATIM and Government Serchhip College had their first meeting through Google Meet. The meeting was hosted by Associate Professor F.Lalengzauvi Head of Department, Government Serchhip College. After the introduction of faculties, plans were made on how to carry out the Exchange Programme in the most effective and efficient manner. For feedback purposes and for exchanging information between the two colleges, whatsapp group was created where both faculties of HATIM and Government Serchhip College were added in the group.

The Plan was put into action on 15th and 16thSeptember 2021 where 3 classes each (two classes in first semester and one class in third semester) were taken up by both the colleges. Both the parties have learnt that student's participation in responding and interacting with the teachers was quite satisfactory. Although the number of students attending the class was not up to the mark, however the session was so insightful, fruitful and interesting for both the teachers and students. Apparently, new faces, new experiences and differences in styles of teaching adopted by the new teacher motivated the learner which is an important element of an effective teaching-learning process.
