BACHELOR OF ARTS (BA): HISTORY

INTRODUCTION & OBJECTIVES:

The three-years Bachelor's Degree in History follows the Draft Reulations Governing the Choice Based Credit Sysrem (CBCS) and Grading in Undergraduate Programmes (Constituent and Affilated Colleges) of Mizoram University and comprises of a total of 140 Credits.

COURSE OUTCOMES:

The course is designed to familiarize students with the Pre-Colonial era upto the 1960s in Mizoram, socio-economic, religious, political and cultural developments in India and the world as well as the role of an individual in the society from time immemorial to modern times. The curriculum positively prepares a student for various competitive examinations. It also helps the students become better readers, thinkers and good citizens.

BACHELOR OF ARTS (BA): ENGLISH

INTRODUCTION & OBJECTIVES:

The B.A. course with English Literature as its core uses the syllabus prescribed by the Mizoram University. It is a three-year degree course containing 6 semesters.

COURSE AND LEARNING OUTCOMES:

After completion of the course, a student of B.A. (English) will be equipped with knowledge of history of English literature and that of English language. He/she will have gone through systematic learning of Phonetics and its practical usage; will have been equipped with interest in literature and thus, skilled in composition of drama, short stories, plays, poems, fiction etc. The curriculum also sharpens a student interested in theatre art through practical learning. The English Department of the Institute looks after the Theatre Club of the Institute.





BACHELOR OF ARTS (BA): PHILOSOPHY

INTRODUCTION & OBJECTIVES:

The Department of Philosophy aims at providing quality in Logic, critical thinking, ethics and traditional approach to different theories of both Indian and Western Philosophy and also to practical philosophy across semesters within three years under the CBCS system of learning adopted by the Mizoram University.

COURSE AND LEARNING OUTCOMES:

After completion of the B.A. (Philosophy) course a student will be well equipped with -

- a) ability in critical thinkings and forming aguments thereby enhancing the student logical reasoning accumen. This helps immensely in appearing for various competitive examinations such as banking, civil services etc.
- b) understanding of moral concepts and principles and apply them practically in their day to day life. c) ability to read and comprehend philosophical texts and form argument, thereby enabling to think rationally about any philosophical idoelogies relevant to both theoretical and practical aspects of it.

The curriculum also helps in organising, recognising and expressing arguments which may be interdisciplinary in nature.

BACHELOR OF ARTS (BA): EDUCATION

INTRODUCTION & OBJECTIVES:

The Under Graduate Bachelor of Arts in Education is a three year degree course. The general objective of the course is to help students acquire extensive knowledge about educational concepts, ideas, methods and applications.

COURSE AND LEARNING OUTCOMES:

After completing a three year degree course in Education, the students will:

- (i) Be well acquainted with the basic tenets of education.
- (ii) Understand the educational concepts and ideas and will be able to explain them in their own words.
- (iii) Use their acquired knowledge for the purpose of creating new ideas, methods and solutions to problems.

BACHELOR OF ARTS (BA): PSYCHOLOGY

INTRODUCTION & OBJECTIVES:

The Bachelor of Arts in Psychology aims to develop knowledge in the core domains of Psychology. It focuses on implementing ethical behaviour in research and practical field, and to equip students with an awareness of one's behaviour, to ways of interacting and influencing others, and to their roles in society as responsible individual. It is a three-year degree course and follows Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) syllabus prescribed by Mizoram University.

COURSE AND LEARNING OUTCOMES:

After completion of the course, a student of B.A (Psychology) will be equipped with: The knowledge of key concepts, principles and themes in Psychology thereby becoming an intellectually competent individual in the field of psychology. He/she will possess an understanding and implementation of ethical principles in the field of research and conducting experiments. Student will have the awareness, sensitivity and skills to work with individuals from a diverse range of backgrounds and characteristics. The curriculum will enrich their minds with knowledge of how to cope and handle problems ethically, and take into account the rights and needs of those they serve as well as society as a whole, and further assist them to become a responsible individual in the society.

QUALIFICATION CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION

Considering the criteria laid out by Mizoram University, the qualification criteria of candidates who are eligible to take admission for the new Academic session are as below:

Option 3

PHILOSOPHY and ENGLISH

- (i) Bachelor of Arts (BA): All streams with 45% aggregate marks in 10+2 for General and 5% relaxation for SC/ST/OBC.
- (ii) Bachelor of Commerce (B.Com): Only with Commerce background with 45% aggregate marks in 10+2 for General and 5% relaxation for SC/ST/OBC.
- (iii) Bachelor of Computer Applications (BCA): All streams with 50% aggregate marks in 10+2 for General and 5% relaxation for SC/ST/OBC.
- (iv) Bachelor of Social Work (BSW): All streams with 45% aggregate marks in 10+2 for General and 5% relaxation for SC/ST/OBC.

RESERVATION OF SEATS

The following reservations can be made for the allotment of seats:

- (i) 5% for Lawngtlai District
- (ii) 5% Sports Quota
- (iii) 2% for differently-abled
- (iv) 5% for BCM employees children
- (v) 5% for Economically Weaker Section (EWS)
- Candidates securing 60% (First Class) and above in Class 12 examination will be eligible for Direct Admission.
- Candidates securing less than 60% marks in Class 12 examination will have to go through Personal Interview.
